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Superduo Bangles

Wear them alone. Wear them stacked. These Superduo bangles using the lovely colour mixes are just the thing to match your mood. Simple weaving makes these bangles really fun and quick to finish.

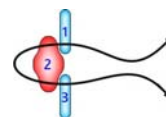

Step 1



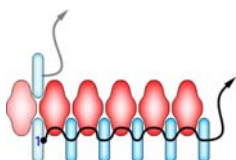
On a 6 m (6.5 yards) length of Fireline, place 2 needles. Tie the 2 ends together to form a loop leaving a 15 cm (6") tail at each end. Place a needle at each end of the loop.

Step 2



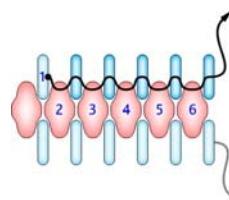
Using one needle, string 1B, 1C and move them to the middle of the doubled thread. You will only be passing through one of the holes of the C. Pick up the second needle and pass through the second hole of the C. String 1B.

Step 3



String 1C, 1B five times using only one of the needles.

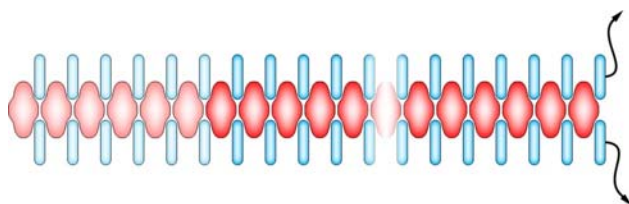
Step 4



Using the second needle, pass the thread through the second hole of bead #2. String 1B. Repeat this for all the newly added C from Step 3.

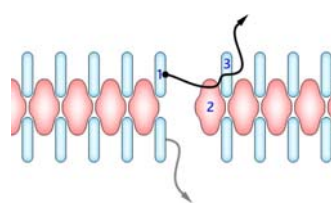


Step 5



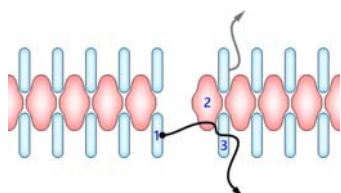
Repeat Steps 3 and 4 placing five sets of B and C at a time until the strip is long enough when joined to go over the widest part of your hand. This will be between 60 to 80 C beads long. Always work in lengths of five sets alternating between the two needles. This will ensure that your weaving is balanced between the two sides. Important : Keep your tension relatively loose.

Step 6



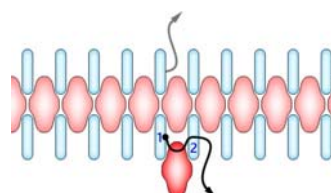
Join the two ends. Using one of the needles, weave through bead #2 then #3. Firmly draw the two ends together.

Step 7



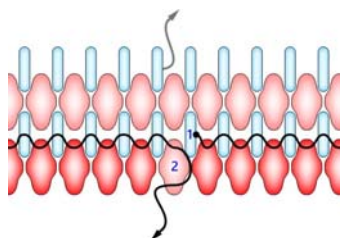
Using the second needle, repeat Step 6 drawing the two ends together. Weave in and secure both the tails that were left earlier.

Step 8



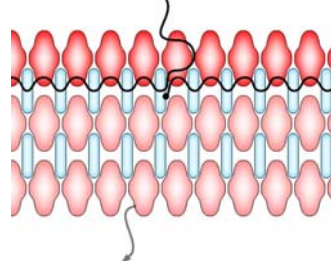
String 1C and pass through bead #2.

Step 9



Repeat Step 8 for all the spaces between the B beads. When done, pass the through the second hole of the C bead placed in Step 8.

Step 10

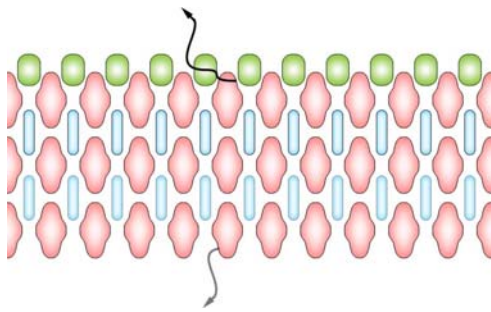


Repeat Steps 8 and 9 for the opposite edge of the weaving. Always alternate between the two sides of your weaving to keep it balanced.



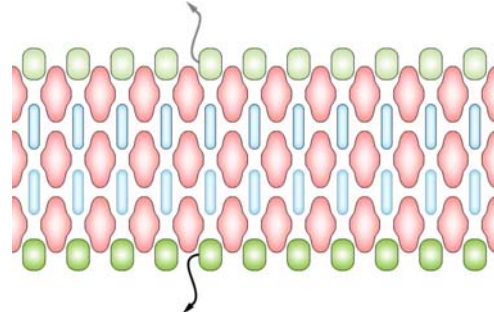


Step 11



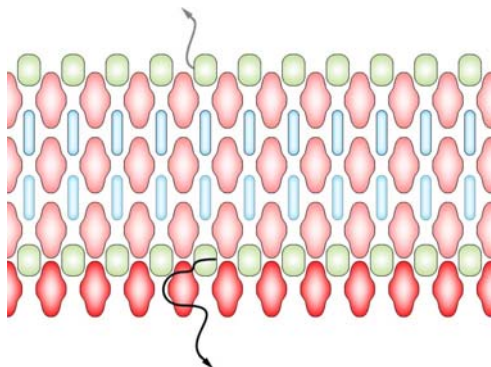
Place 1A in each of the spaces between the C beads.

Step 12



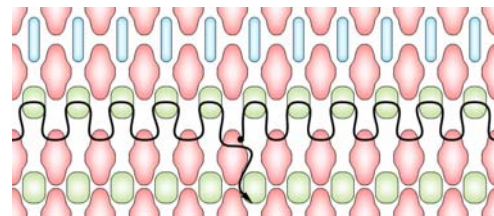
Working on the opposite edge, place 1A in each of the spaces between the C beads.

Step 13



Place 1C in each of the spaces between the A beads. When done, weave through the second hole of the first C placed.

Step 14



Roll the edges outwards so that they meet. Using the longer of the two threads, weave to and fro between the A and C beads from each edge drawing the edges close. Be careful, keep your tension loose or the beads will crack. Secure and trim all the working threads when done.
